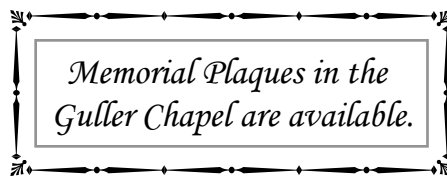

A sign of the times. That saying certainly applies to Shaare Zedek. If you haven't noticed, Shaare Zedek has a new sign greeting everyone that passes by on Hanley and Amherst avenues. The sign depicts the stain glass windows found in both the synagogue and the chapel. The sign and accompanying base were graciously donated by Jeff and Shelley Dean and Alan and Helene Spetner. The sign helps tell the community and everyone that passes by that Shaare Zedek is on the move and constantly changing.

We cannot afford to remain the same. Last month I summarized the changes that are taking place at the United Synagogue for Conservative Judaism (USCJ). The USCJ realizes that it needs to reinvent itself as an organization and as a supporter of Conservative Judaism. What has worked in the past is no longer working. The number of people that define themselves as Conservative Jews has been declining at a rapid rate over the last two decades. There is a saying that goes-the definition of

insanity is continuing to do the same thing and expecting a different result. We need to be constantly evaluating ourselves as a congregation and as an entity that has a community presence.

In the next few weeks you will be asked to participate in one of our new fundraisers. We are calling it the "Shaare Zedek Gold Rush". Basically, we are asking you all to be prospector's and look in your jewelry boxes. Maybe you have one earring from a matching set, or a gold chain that is lying uselessly in your drawer. Old earring posts, pinkie rings which haven't fit for years or class rings from the 1970's or earlier. Today they all have value, and we are asking you to donate these items to our Gold Rush campaign. We have a modest goal of collecting 50 ounces of gold which should net the shul about \$70,000. If we can accomplish that we will be taking a big step in improving our financial situation. This is an opportunity for everyone to participate with very little effort. The committee will do all the work. They will even come to your home and pick up your

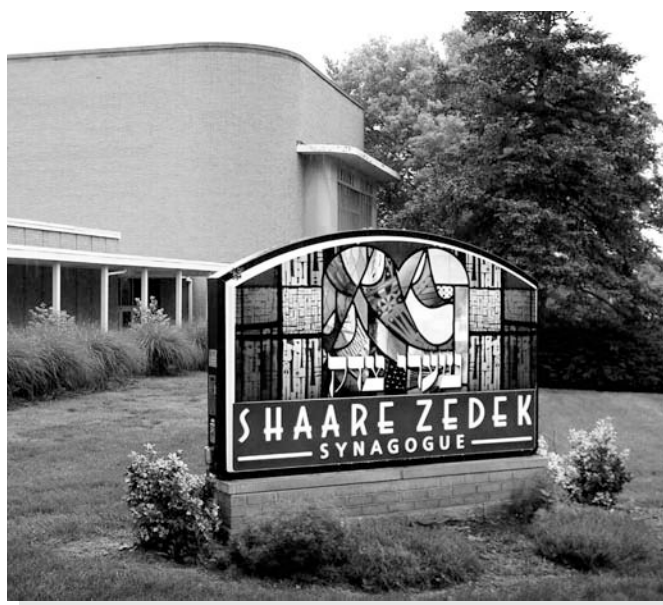
items. Please watch for regular mailings and emails that further describe the Gold Rush campaign.
