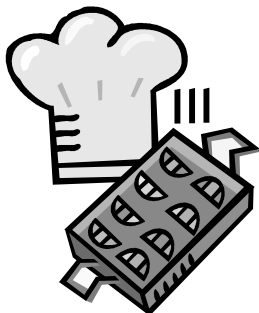

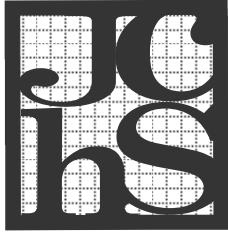

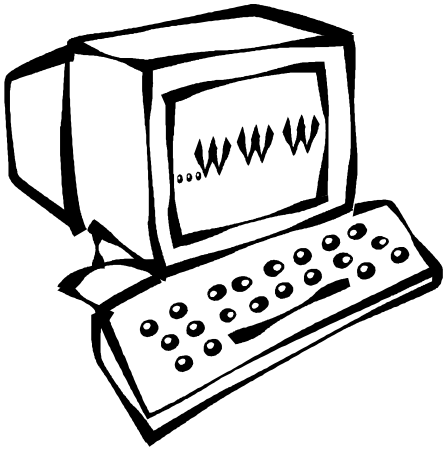

Everyone Has a Story:

The Story of Jerry and Ida Legow

Jerry and Ida Legow, who recently celebrated their 63rd wedding anniversary, are long-time members of Shaare Zedek as were many of Ida's family members. In fact, her brother, Norman Imber, is a past president. And, Jerry states that the two main jobs in his life are taking care of Ida and standing at the door of SZ during High Holiday services. He has seen four generations of SZ members go through those doors.

Jerry Legow, the youngest of eight children, was born outside of Cleveland, Ohio, where his father had a hardware store. After high school, Jerry went to Cleveland College, but in 1941 (right after Pearl Harbor), he volunteered for military service.

Meanwhile, Ida was born and raised in Belleville, IL, where she lived with her parents and three brothers. After high school, Ida worked for the Jewish Welfare Board of the USO. Her family owned and operated a number of men's clothing stores.

Jerry and Ida met in 1942 at the USO in Belleville; they married a year later. At first, Jerry was stationed at various bases in the USA, and Ida went with him; but when Jerry was sent overseas, Ida returned to Belleville and lived with her family while working in her brother's clothing store.

When the war was over in 1945, instead of being discharged, Jerry, who was a commanding officer, was told that he and his men were "no longer members of the U.S. Army's 1st Division; they were members of the International Military Tribunal." As a result, Jerry served as security officer during the Nuremberg Trials, and he didn't return until the Germans were sentenced 11 months later. For his service, Jerry was awarded the Silver Star, the Bronze Star, France's Croix de Guerre, and the Purple Heart!

Afterwards Ida's family wanted the couple to live close, so Jerry was asked to join the family's clothing business. During his 60 years in the business, Jerry operated the store in Edwardsville (he still works there 4 days a week). The Legows have two married children and two grandchildren.

Over the years, Ida has been a very active community volunteer, giving generously of her time to Meals on Wheels, AMC, and NCJW. A major hobby of hers is painting, examples of which are displayed throughout their home. Jerry, too, stays busy, serving as MC for the Edwardsville Halloween Parade and giving talks at SIU-Edwardsville and the St. Louis Holocaust Museum. The couple has also enjoyed participating in the musical plays of B'nai B'rith, The Players, ORT, and especially SZ.

In thinking back over their lives, Ida feels blessed that she has had a good husband, good children, and a good life. Jerry's final comment was, "I was looking for a best friend and that's what I found in Ida."
